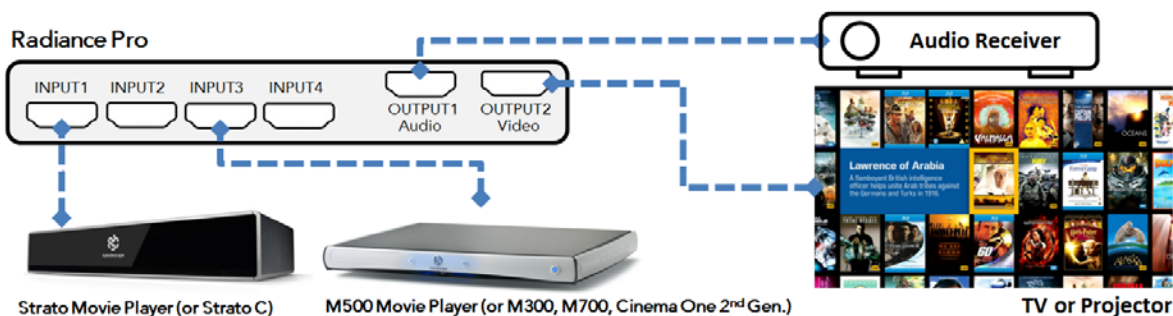




Kaleidescape Co-Star for Lumagen Quick Start

Purchasing the Kaleidescape Co-Star software license for Lumagen allows a Radiance Pro to act as a Co-Star switch, simplifying installation and supporting legacy AV receivers without HDMI 2.0 capabilities.

1. Install the Lumagen Radiance Pro and verify your HDMI cables meet [Lumagen's criteria](#).
2. After updating software on the Kaleidescape players, connect similarly to below, with Strato to an 18 GHz input. Avoid adjacent inputs (1&2, 3&4, etc) for best switching performance.



3. On the Lumagen remote, press *ON*, *Input* and Strato's input number to see Strato's OSD.
4. Press *Menu*, *0*, *5*, *7*, *6* to enable Co-Star mode. Set **Enable** to **On**. Ensure the displayed input numbers match the connections above. Press *OK* to exit.
5. **IMPORTANT:** Press *Menu*, choose **Save** and press *OK* to persist the Co-Star mode settings.
6. In Strato's Browser Interface, navigate to **Settings** and select **System & Player Pairing**.
7. If pairing with an Alto player, click **Enable Player Pairing**.
8. If pairing with a Premiere or Cinema One player, click **Setup System Pairing**, then:
 - a. Choose this player from the pop-up window and click **Pair With This System**.
 - b. Once paired, name the system pair if desired, and click **OK**. Refer to the Co-Star Installation Guide before changing the SD and HD Download Destination setting.
9. The **Pair Players** section should contain two pull-down menus. Select the player you paired with the Strato, and select **Lumagen Radiance Pro** as the switching mode. Click **OK**.
10. Verify that Strato now displays titles from your paired Premiere system or Alto, and that the Radiance Pro switches correctly to the paired player when you play those movies.
